

Before you read this week's "WHAT'S NEWS," I feel the need to say and remember.....



THINGS TO REMEMBER...



FOR YOUR IMMEDIATE ATTENTION PLEASE! PLEASE REVIEW THE FOLLOWING...

1. When I hear a President say, "I am new at this, I didn't know" after game one I wonder why they did not ask before game one, the person on top needs to be on top of things, please ask. How can one be a leader if you can't lead yourself to the information highway? Don't yell at me because this does not sound like positive support as I preached in the last line of my letter, but I think positively that a Chapter President needs to hold themselves to a higher standard.
2. Chapter Presidents, please keep your field clear of excess people on the side lines.....I saw fields with gates wide open and no one manning them!
3. Must Play Sheets that are filled out by the head coach, please instruct them how it is to be filled out. Hint: read your rule book page 23, Article VII, Section C, par 16a, 16b, 16c & 16h.
4. HOME FIELDS--YOU MUST HAVE A CLOCK!!! Read your rule book page 13, Article IV, Section A, par 2f.
5. Please display your ADULT CODE OF CONDUCT banners at all home fields (in a clearly visible place).
6. Jerseys must be worn in agreement with the CIF standards, no knots what so ever are to be made if jersey is to big alter it.
7. NO CELL PHONES!
8. COACHES WEAR YOUR HATS APPROPRIATELY!
9. Coaches Box limit is the 25-yard line.
10. WHO IS IN CHARGE OF WEIGH-INS? The home team ! Visiting teams get weighed in first, unless they are late. FOR CHEER ONLY. After the weigh-in process has been completed, the Host CHAPTER GAME DAY COMPLIANCE AGENT will go to the cheer area and ask for the cheer courtesy roster and take head count, they will mark off the cheerleaders that are absent. Then the courtesy roster will be turned in with the football game day sheets and mailed to the OCJAAF Athletic Director (Wanda Hadley). Remember the home team has the responsibility to mail in the game day sheets and they must be in

Wanda's hands by the Thursday following game day. As a reminder to the host chapter in regards to taking attendance of the cheer teams your authority in this respect is only to take attendance. You cannot enforce any penalty for late cheerleaders by informing them they cannot participate.

11. PRESIDENTS: Have your coaches go through the "chain-of-command," they need to call YOU on game day--NOT ME! You need to be the first to know.
12. Chapter Game Day Player Compliance Agents (C.G.D.P.C.A.) is a must: 2 from each team is required: 1-pair (home & visitor CGDPCA) work each side of the field (home or visitor). You must provide a current OCJAAF ID badge and it must be visible at all times on the game field.
13. Just a matter of courtesy, visiting teams and spectators should not bring in their own food or drinks. Chapters with home games depend upon the income they generate from their snack bar sales, and besides it is a lot of work not to be successful. Some high school stadiums will forbid anyone bringing in their own food or drinks. Please be courteous and support each other. Thank you!
14. Teams that are playing in a stadium that has the new turf field, please respect the rules of the stadium. No food or drinks accept water on the playing field at all times. We do not want to lose the privilege of the use of the field.
15. Presidents please call in scores by 10am each Sunday morning, or your chapter will be donating \$\$\$\$ to our Scholarship fund.
16. CHEERMust be in full uniform by the 3rd game.
17. All teams will play as long as they have 11 certified players (8 for flag) who show up on game day, this game will be played as a \$100.00 forfeit, if no game is played then it will be a \$300.00 forfeit.
18. Please **READ YOUR RULE BOOK!!!!!!** We had many coaches arguing about jocks and shoes this week, the rule book says that you must wear a jock, it says nothing about a cup, a girdle or any kind of sports

- shorts just an athletic supporter. So please stop arguing with the Game Day Player Compliance Agent and buy your kids a jock. Next is the issue of shoes...if the rule book says, "no detachable cleats" so don't ask if they are rubber can they be detachable because I will say look in our rule book on page 15, Article IV, Section C, par 1i and by the way read all of Article IV, Section C, par 1A-1K.
19. Respect EVERYONE and in doing so you will respect yourself.
 20. Once a player crosses the scale and is overweight (OW), that child **cannot** re-weigh and enter the game. WOW I cannot believe that I need to even say this! (Must of happened, HUH???!!!!).
 21. Once a player crosses the scale and are overweight (OW), the Host Chapter cannot over ride the outcome and allow the child to play. AGAIN WOW I cannot believe that I need to even say this! (Must of happened double HUH???!!!!).
 22. Our kids are all now in school and we are at 3 practices a week please push the books, support the OCJAAF Scholastic program! Remember our OCJAAF ALL ACADEMIC TEAM, live it, breath it, feel it and support it. Our youth are our future. Thank You, your Commissioner Bob Barna.
 23. Players with a soft or hard cast may play as long as the doctor has released him or her to play and a copy of that doctors release must be kept in the player's contract sleeve. The cast must be padded and the officials on the field have the final say as to the padding requirements. No weight allowance will be given for the cast but the padding can be added after the scale process but before weigh-ins are over.
 24. Please respect the Home Chapter and their field; eat their food do not tailgate or sell your food in the bleachers (even if you want to call it a fundraiser). Also help out by picking up your trash. It boils down to respect and treat others as you want them to treat you. THAT SIMPLE.....THAT DIRECT!
 25. PLEASE UP HOLD THE HIGH STANDARDS OF OCJAAF--the lack of knowledge of the Rule Book (read it and embrace it) is only your fault not mine. Please accept that fact...
 26. Please have fun and let our kids play ball and cheer in a pleasant atmosphere. Keep your yelling to yourself not at our kids or our volunteers.
 27. COACHES HATS must be worn per OCJAAF standard and that is with the front in the front. COACHES WEAR YOUR HATS APPROPRIATELY! (Yes this is what I said in #8 above just wanted to make it clear).
 28. COACHES PANTS...I will just sing, "pants on the ground.....pants on the ground.....lookin' 'like a fool with your...pants on the ground..."
 29. COACHES...we ask our players to be in the proper attire on game day all I ask is for you to respect that and show a good example!
 30. 10 min half-time to be used to talk to players and make adjustments for 2nd half. Referees are not going to warn coaches when the warm up period begins! The timer is instructed to put 10 minutes on the clock (at the half-time break) and when it runs out to reset the clock for 5-minutes (warm-up period). It is the Coaches responsibility to have his team back on field for warm-up period. Warm-up period is to stretch and warm-up. Teams are to be ready to go at the end of the warm-up period. Your time keepers must post the 10 min time and the 5 min warm-up time appropriately.
 31. "NO" OCJAAF ID---"NO" COACH!
 32. Player pictures due by Game 3---NO PICTURE, NO PLAY!
 33. FUTURE LEAGUE RULES: A pass or fumble which has not touched the ground is a live ball and therefore can be caught and advanced by either team. (Page 60, article III, sect A, par 1a).
 34. FUTURE LEAGUE RULES: A flag is not removed by grabbing and pulling does not cause play to stop. In all situations where play is in progress and a ball carrier loses one or both flags either accidentally, inadvertently, or on purpose, de-flagging reverts to a one-handed touch of the ball carrier between the shoulders and the knees. (Page 70, article VI, section B, par 14a(1)).
 35. The home chapter must e-mail scores to FOOTBALLMAN@EARTHLINK.NET by 10am Sunday.

36. The HOME TEAM is responsible for change of jersey color if a jersey conflict exists. The OCJAAF inserts "conflicts" into our game schedule as a courtesy to the game day Officials. However, the ultimate decision is the Officials on the field and if there is enough contrast between the teams, the Official may allow it. This is not a reason for a forfeiture of a game and when applicable a penalty will be assessed for non-compliance as reported by the game Official.
37. **HOME CHAPTERS:** In the event that Officials are late or absent at your field please call 1-562-755-8612 ASAP. Only one (1) person from the host field can call. (We don't want parents or coaches calling for the same reason). Please also ensure you are using the OFFICIALS' SIGN-IN SHEET and remember to mail it to the OCJAAF Supervisor of Officials (address is indicated at the bottom of the sign-in sheet). Thank you.
38. **NEW CIF RULE FOR 2011: MERCY RULE**
Effective Fall, 2011, a mercy rule will be in effect for all football contests in the C.I.F. Southern Section, which includes pre-season games, league games

and playoff games, including Championship Finals. This means that if one team has a lead of 35 points or more at the end of three quarters, there will be a running clock for the 4th quarter until the end of the game. If the team wishes to invoke a running clock prior to the start of the 4th quarter, they can do so by mutual agreement of both head coaches.

39. The OCJAAF Presidents have voted a rule change on the 18 Pt Rule. Again, this interpretation is only applicable when a team is behind by 18 or more. There will be NO inside kicks when a team is ahead by 18 pts. If, during the kickoff by K, the ball is touched by K before the ball travels 10yds on, bean bag the spot of first touching and throw flag. If R recovers and advances beyond this spot, then give result of run. If R or K recovers the ball behind the spot of first touching, bring the ball to the spot of first touching and award ball to R.
40. Nothing to say or tell you I just wanted to end this part with an even number...
